New Business

- Family Fun Night- Discussion occurred regarding the original plan to host a skating event at Skate Night on Oct 23rd. The information that was given regarding the fee schedule does not apply to singular events. So to host this event privately it will cost \$300.00 for a 2 hour event as opposed to the estimated \$150. It was voted on to switch the October date to the 26th from 5-8 pm. The Reef offers a return to schools for hosting events of \$1.95 per swimmer up to 100 people, then \$2.00. Megan suggested that we simply return that fee exchange to the students and reduce their entry fee from \$10.95 per swimmer to \$9.00. We voted in agreement and Krista will check on allowing spectators to enter for free.

- 2-4-6 Reading Celebration- Incentive planning. Discussion occurred about potential rewards and incentives for this event. Commentary included a Nook/Kindle, MP3 downloads, Meal Coupons, pencils and to trinkets for smaller prizes. Members will plant o brainstorm and bring their ideas to the next meeting for further discussion

- Scholastic Book Fair- Has been relocated to the fall as not to compete with MCT and Reading Month. We voted to host it in conjunction with Fall Parent Teacher Conferences and shorten availability to 3 days instead of four. Those dates are Nov 6-8th. The hours this year will be 12-7 pm to decreasing our daytime volunteer needs and expand our

evening hours to co-inside with conference times. Kim and Krista will coordinate the volunteer schedule. Those available are asked to email their options to Krista

- Website progress- Original updates as requested have been made. Further content has yet to be made available yet. Mr. Lipp is working with us on a plan to manage our portion of the website for a quicker return on editing. We want to consider the option of managing the website ourselves.

- Fall fundraising efforts have yielded \$1330. Discussion occurred regarding the idea of supporting the technology initiatives again this year. Mr. Lipp reports that Promethean is continuing to run their matching funds option again. The group voted to make another donation of \$1750 to the school on for this purpose. It will allow us to obtain an additional 2 white boards.
