

# MINUTES

## **Canyon Creek School's PTO Minutes**

*March 10, 2015*

The meeting was called to order by Becca Sedlacek @ 6:30 p.m.

### **In attendance**

### **Treasurer Report**

- We have \$5650 in the checking account.

### **Old Business**

- The Book Fair was a success!
  - Thank you to Kim Harper for once again coordinating the event and to all the volunteers.
  - \$3,566.96 in total sales
    - About ½ of that comes back to the school in books
  - All the teachers had their wish lists filled and the library received a large stack of books as well
- The Reading Challenge was also a success!
  - 86 total students participated (K-2<sup>nd</sup> = 48, 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> = 24, 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>=14)
  - We raised \$1,534.50
  - Total expenses were \$564.94
    - Bikes - \$99.94
    - Barnes and Noble Gift Card - \$440.00
    - Pizza Party - \$25 (Mrs. Vogl's second grade class won this for raising the most money)
  - The Rimrock Mason's donated 2 bikes and 2 Kindles. We signed a thank you note for them.

### **New Business**

- Art night will be held Friday, March 13 at 6pm-8pm. We signed thank you notes for the artists during the meeting. We also discussed a few last minute volunteer positions that we needed to be filled and everything is now covered.
- The Community Dinner and Basket Raffle will be held April 24 at 6pm-8pm. Becca will get the basket raffle information to the teachers so that they can choose a basket theme and send out to the students in their class. We discussed what the money raised from the basket raffle should go to this year. Becca, Sarah T. and Jeanne are going to meet with Mr. Lipp on Friday, March 20<sup>th</sup> to discuss some potential large projects that PTO could look at trying to fund. The feeling at the meeting was that we probably had more money in our checking account than what we felt comfortable with so we would like to pick a project to put extra money in the checking account and the money raised in the basket raffle towards. We will need a few volunteers during the Community Dinner to help serve desert and drinks and sell raffle tickets. If you are interested in helping out please let Becca know.
- We discussed approaching Mr. Rice about giving a monetary donation towards the 8<sup>th</sup> grade class trip since they had one of their tournaments to sell concessions at cancelled. We agreed that if they needed additional support we would donate towards the trip.
